SUMMARY OF ACHIEVMENTS AND ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR:

Catholic School Council continued to support a wide variety of school initiatives in the 2015-2016 school year. Highlights included: a chocolate fundraiser, two movie nights, PRO Grant Parent Engagement evening focused on mathematics, Play Day. Catholic School Council also provided support for school event nights such as Open House, Christmas Open House, Graduation, etc. Through funds raised CSC at Father C.W. Sullivan supported the following:

- \$3000 spent on technology for the school, allowing for the purchase of a SMART Board (to be installed)
- \$500 spent on Religious Artifacts for our classrooms, including new virtues plaques
- \$3000 put forward to support our annual Play Day event
- \$1500 put forward to support educator wish list items for augmentation of programs
- \$300 spent for student recognition items such as Virtues pencils, pins recognizing the receipt of Sacraments for Grades 2 and 8 students
- \$300 spent to support Athletics programs and initiatives

Catholic School Council continued to support programs and initiatives that focus on bettering the student experience at Father C.W. Sullivan School.
